### **Vocational opportunities:**

This course provides successful candidates with the qualification required to be employed as a Pathology collector within the health industry.

### **Course Structure:**

The program is composed of 14 units: 6 compulsory and 8 elective units.

The elective units offered by MHS Training Pty. Ltd. are listed; these electives have been selected by MHS Training Pty Ltd to provide maximum employment opportunities. This course involves practical as well as theoretical components. The practical component, at the end of the program, is conducted within the Pathology Collection industry.

The total number of hours including one week clinical placement is 348 hours.

### **Assessment:**

Assessment may include a variety of approaches: Practical sessions, written & oral tests, assignments and practical placement.

### **Eligibility:**

The ability to read, comprehend discuss and analyse printed information in English and to write statements is a necessary course and work requirement.

This course includes blood collection and students are required to be immunized against Hepatitis B.

Inoculations should begin prior to the commencement of study.
